DEADLINE TO APPLY IS OCT. 16, 2023

The 2023-2024 East Fort Worth Business Association Wanda Conlin Scholarship Program is open to seniors from east Fort Worth high schools who plan on attending any institution of higher learning, trade or technical school. Seven (7) students will be selected for \$1,500 scholarships. Awards will be made in person at the annual EFWBA banquet Nov. 9, 6-8 p.m., at Texas Wesleyan University.

Recipients of scholarships will be notified the week of Oct. 23.

Top consideration will be given to applicants who (in order):

- 1. Have a history of community and extracurricular involvement and leadership
- 2. Exhibit excellent academic achievement as demonstrated by grades and difficulty of classes
- 3. Have overcome personal hardship through perseverance and an unwavering commitment

Applicants MUST adhere to the following:

- 1. CLEARLY complete the application form and return it with a readable copy of the most recent student transcript to EFWBA2023@yahoo.com by midnight Oct. 16.
- 2. Have academically completed the last two years (current year included) at one of the following schools: Eastern Hills; Dunbar; Nolan; Polytechnic; Young Men's Leadership Academy; Texans CAN Academy.
- 3. Attend the Nov. 9, 2023, 6-8 p.m., awards banquet at Texas Wesleyan University. The winners and one (1) guest each will be hosted at the event. Additional tickets may be purchased.
- 4. Plan on attending an institution of higher learning, technical or trade school after high school.
- 5. Submit an essay <u>no longer than</u> one-page double-spaced, 12-point type, one-inch margins. Essay may include goals, future career path, hardships encountered, etc., to support why they should be considered for the award. Grammar, spelling and creativity will be considered.
